HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT TEST AT BBHS... The Diocesan Placement Exam for incoming freshmen will be held Saturday, December 10th from 9:00 am. – 12 Noon in Hegenauer Hall. Results of the test serve as the basis for the seven academic merit scholarships to be awarded by BBHS. [Click here](#) to register.

Please arrive by 8:45 am to the main entrance. All materials will be provided for the test. No calculators allowed.

We encourage parents to stay for coffee, doughnuts, and an informational session starting at 9:15 in the Munninghoff Family Performing Arts Center that will last approximately 15 - 20 minutes. This session will focus on the registration process, placement considerations, scholarships and tuition assistance.

Students that cannot take the test on this date must take the test on a makeup date scheduled with the guidance office. Only students who take the test on the 10th at Bishop

Brossart are eligible for the merit scholarships given to the top performing students. If a student takes the test at another high school but wishes to have a copy of the scores sent to BBHS, they must indicate so when completing the test form.

VERY IMPORTANT NOTE... Current diocesan guidelines encourage students to take the exam at any high school they wish. But, they will only be eligible for the academic scholarships from the school where the test was taken. For information please call the BBHS main office at 859-635-2108.
