24/25 TUITION/REGISTRATION

We wanted to share tuition information along with the new process for registering for next school year.

TUITION

We will be having a 4% tuition increase for next school year. We have been able to hold that at 2.5% the last two years, but we needed to go to 4% this year. We will also be going to ONE FEE for tuition. In the past we have collected a \$100 registration fee, a class level fee, and tuition. This year, and moving forward, we will only do a single tuition charge. Below is a breakdown of how this works.

2023-24 tuition rate for in-diocese: \$7,780 + \$100 registration fee + class level fee (FR/SO \$400, JR \$425, SR \$575)

2024-25 tuition rate for in-diocese: \$8,090 (4% increase) + \$100 registration + \$450 (average class level fee) = \$8,640

In-Diocese tuition rate for 2024-25 is \$8,640.

No registration fee or class level fee. All included in tuition.

Out of Diocese tuition rate for 2024-25 will be \$9,445.

No registration fee or class level fee. All included in tuition.

24/25 REGISTRATION - Due May 15th - NEW PROCESS!

Online registration for 24/25 is now open. We are moving to a 2-step process within Sycamore and FACTS. This will allow you to make updates to the information we have in Sycamore for your family and will allow you make changes to your payment plan in FACTS. See flyer below with instructions.

- **1st Step - Sycamore Enrollment** – Please click the link below to enroll your child for next school year. You will need to know your family Sycamore login ID/password. If you do not know this information, please reach out to the office or Mrs. Lester (slester@bishopbrossart.org). There is no need to send a registration check into school, it has been rolled into the tuition amount.

RETURNING STUDENT REGISTRATION

To register for next school year, families must register online through our school portal, Sycamore –AND- select a payment plan in FACTS for next school year.

Please click the below link or scan the QR code to access the Sycamore registration website.

- You will use your current Sycamore login and password. Once logged in, click the  icon on your home screen and select Admissions and then select your child's name.
- Once in Sycamore most of your information will be pre-populated based on prior input. Please verify all information is correct and make any necessary changes. There will be some new questions that we will need you to complete along with any forms you may need to resubmit for the new school year (Large Family Discount, Bus Transportation, etc).

1. Registration is complete and submitted in Sycamore
2. A Payment Plan for next school year has been selected in FACTS

Tuition Charges/Scholarships/Financial Aid (if applicable) will be added to your tuition account over the summer. You will receive an email statement from FACTS when it has been entered in early July.
